Tanana Lakes is a Multi-Use Facility

- **THE TRAIL SYSTEM IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC 7 DAYS A WEEK. PLEASE NOTE THAT ALTHOUGH TRAILS MAY BE OPEN, CONDITIONS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.**
- **ALL TRAILS ARE TWO-WAY TRAILS AND CAN BE USED IN EITHER DIRECTION.**
- **PLEASE REMAIN ALERT TO ONCOMING TRAFFIC, AND BE COURTEOUS WHEN MEETING OR APPROACHING OTHERS.**
- **AVOID HIKING, DOG USE, AND OTHER ACTIVITIES THAT CAN DEGRADE OR DAMAGE GROOMED TRAIL SURFACES THAT ARE MARKED FOR SKIING.**
- **PORTIONS OF THE TRAILS CROSS ROADWAYS, AND SNOW MACHINE TRAILS. PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION.**
- **DOGS ENJOY THE OUTDOORS TOO, JUST REMEMBER TO KEEP THEM ON A LEASH AND PICK-UP AFTER YOUR PET.**
- **NO SHOOTING IN THE PARK. PLEASE USE RIFLE RANGE.**
- **NO FIREWORKS ALLOWED.**
- **CAMPING IS NOT PERMITTED.**
- **PLEASE RESPECT YOUR PARK - DO NOT LITTER.**
- **NO CAMPFIRES.**

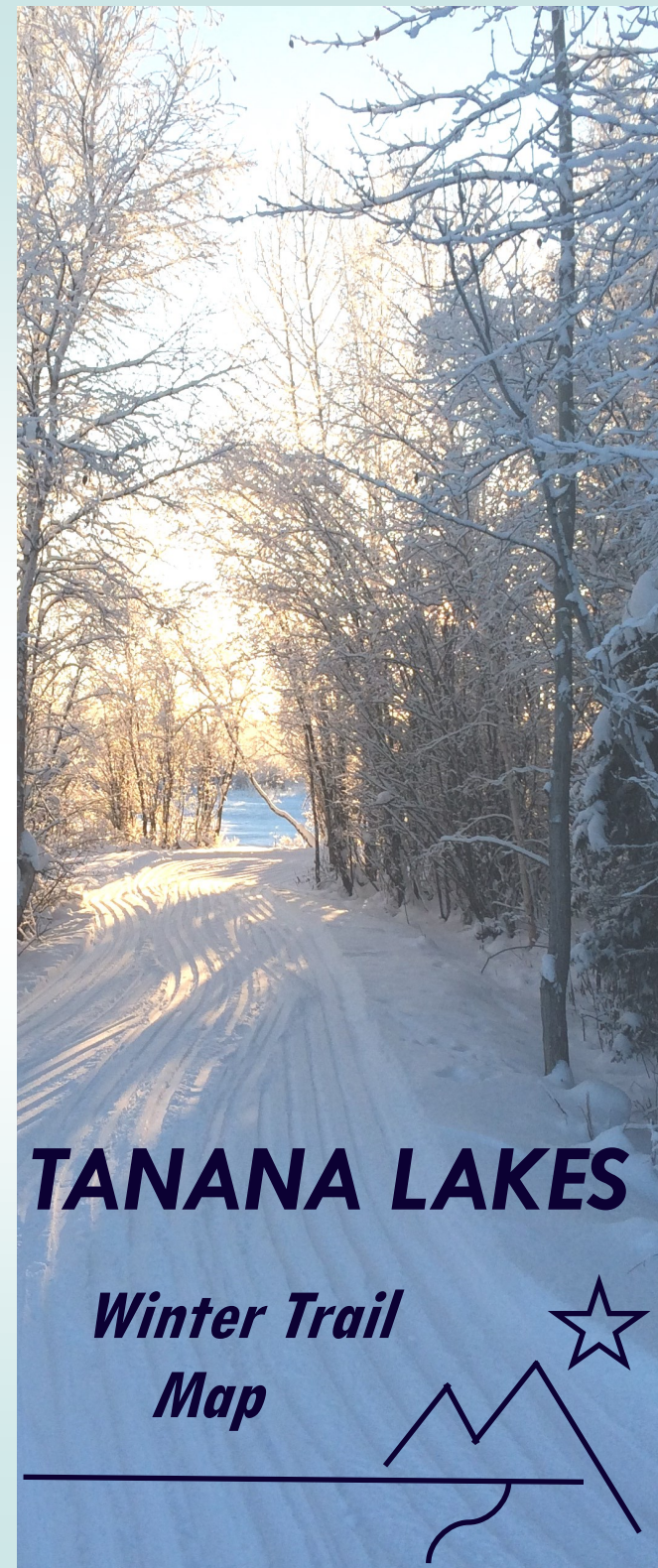
