MENU OF SUGGESTED TOPICS FAIRBANKS AT 50+

Art and science of caregiving:

Skills for supporting safe care, communication skills, networking, support, career paths in caregiving Create, recreate, growth, wellness:

Arts, education, fitness, activities, fulfillment-purpose, travel

Connections, relationships, social-emotional ties:

Multi-generational life, raising grandchildren, connections with family and friends, volunteerism Health:

Physical and Mental Health topics such as nutrition, strength, sleep, brain-health, balance, conditions and diseases, medications, prevention, recovery, rehabilitation, support, and caring for family-friends

Home matters:

Home modification, safety at home and on the road, snow-bird life, accessary dwelling units (ADU), universal design, transportation, home-based assistance, transition to senior housing, assisted living

Legal and other planning:

Wills, family trusts, retirement investment, fixed-income planning, suddenly solo, downsizing belongings, organizing essential documents, where to find in-home help, seeking new home options

Medical decisions and understanding the rules:

Living wills, advanced directives, healthcare proxies, guardianships, Medicaid waiver, Miller Trust, Medicare, care coordination

Safety and tools

Emergency readiness, security devices for home and travel, fraud prevention, on-line safety Policies, leadership, advocacy:

Politics of aging, government policies and programs, changing Fairbanks demographic, what we need

FORMAT CATEGORIES AND EXAMPLES:

- Exhibit Resource Table: Tabletop display-handouts at exhibit hall resource sharing times (staffed table)
- Exhibit: Promotional sales proposals considered (not during luncheon event hours on Thursday)
