



Chena Lake Recreation Area WINTER TRAILS MAP

Chena Lake Recreation Area is a 2,178 acre park located east of North Pole. The park offers multiple outdoor activities including, skiing, walking, snowshoeing, snow-machining, ice fishing, aurora viewing and photography in the winter.



Hours of Operation

Open Year Round, 24 hours

WINTER ACTIVITIES

Ice Fishing

Chena Lake Recreation Area is stocked with Rainbow Trout, Silver Salmon, and Arctic Char in the winter. The park rents ice-fishing houses by the day. Your ice house rental comes with a bundle of firewood for the woodstove and pre-drilled ice holes.

Skiing and Snowmaching

During the winter months, classical cross-country ski trails at the River Park with 2.5 km , 4.0 km , and 5.5 km loops are groomed. In addition, a multi-use trail with 3.8, 5.5, 6.5, 9.5, and 12 mile loops for snowmachiners, skate skiers, skijors, dog mushers, walkers, and snowshoers is also maintained.

Aurora Viewing

Chena Lake Recreation Area is an excellent location for aurora viewing due to its wide open areas and a large lake, away from the city lights. If you're feeling like a walk, there are several winter trails on and around the lake. We recommend taking a headlamp or a flashlight. Two-wheel drive vehicles are acceptable during the entire Aurora Season except during extreme stormy conditions.

PARK RULES

- Please remain alert to oncoming traffic, and be courteous when meeting or approaching others.
- Portions of the trails cross roadways, and snowmachine trails. Please exercise caution.
- Dogs enjoy the outdoors too. Just remember to keep them on a leash and pick up after your pet.
- NO snowmachines in non-motorized areas.
- NO campfires or fireworks allowed.
- The cutting of trees or brush is prohibited anywhere within the park.
- The use of auxiliary heaters, flammable liquids or explosive gases is prohibited within the ice houses.
- All local, State and Federal laws apply within the Park. A State of Alaska fishing license is required.
- Please respect your park. Do not litter.
